- Final Multi-Resource Management Plan Approval

Proposal to remove language around hunting of elk, and adjust language around recreation impacts to forest on page 30/31 and around language re-benefits to the watershed on Pg. 41. Motion to approve Management Plan for Board with recommended changes.

  - Only have one access point with signage, located at the Hug Point Entrance (north entrance).

- EFM requested site visit 3/28/2023. How do we handle this and in the future? Conversation around what is allowable access to the site, expressed a need for the development of criteria as to what a beneficial site visit looks like. Understanding that Arch Cape is a watershed that could be used as an example for future watershed protection projects, and understanding the partnerships which allowed the Arch Cape Forest to come into Arch Cape Water District Ownership.
